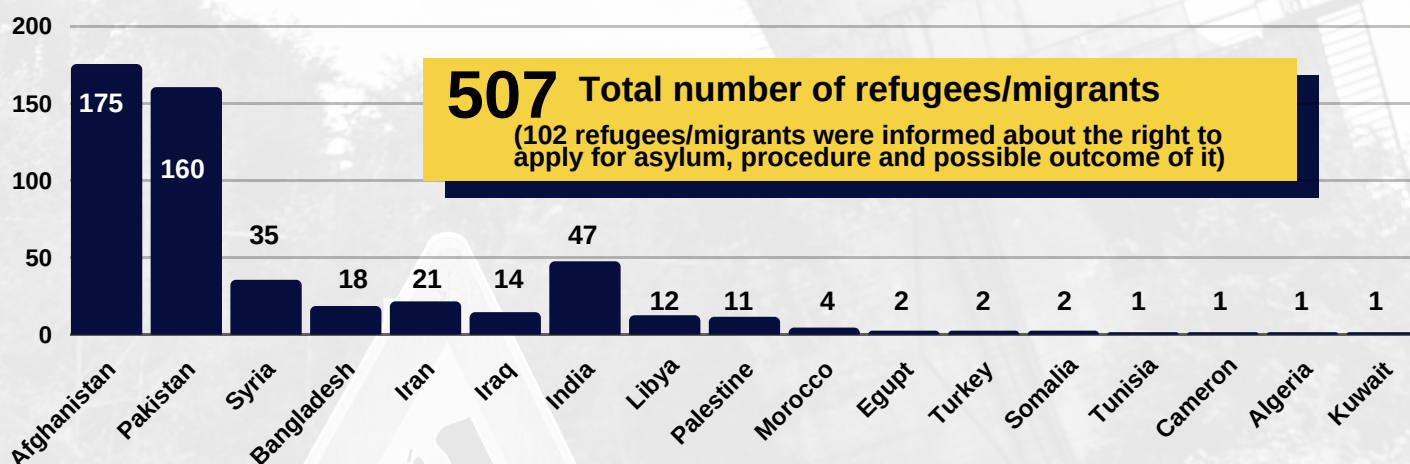

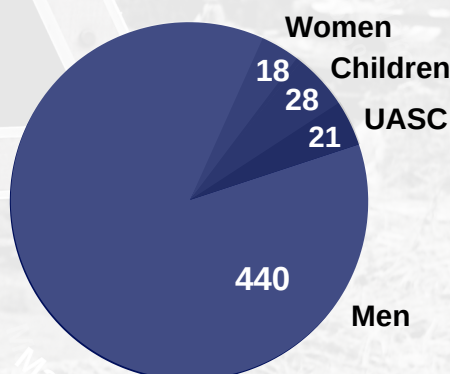

During reporting period in RTC Tabanovce there is increased number of refugees/migrants coming or returning from Serbia. After several unsuccessful attempts to continue their travel to some of the Western European countries, they decide to return to Greece.

The accommodated refugees/migrants are only a small fraction of the total number of the refugees/migrants who were apprehended in attempt to cross state territory irregularly.

At the last day of December daily statistic of the MLSP for the total number of people in the RTC Tabanovce is 4 (1 from Syria, 1 from Morocco and 2 from Pakistan). All of them were registered by the police.

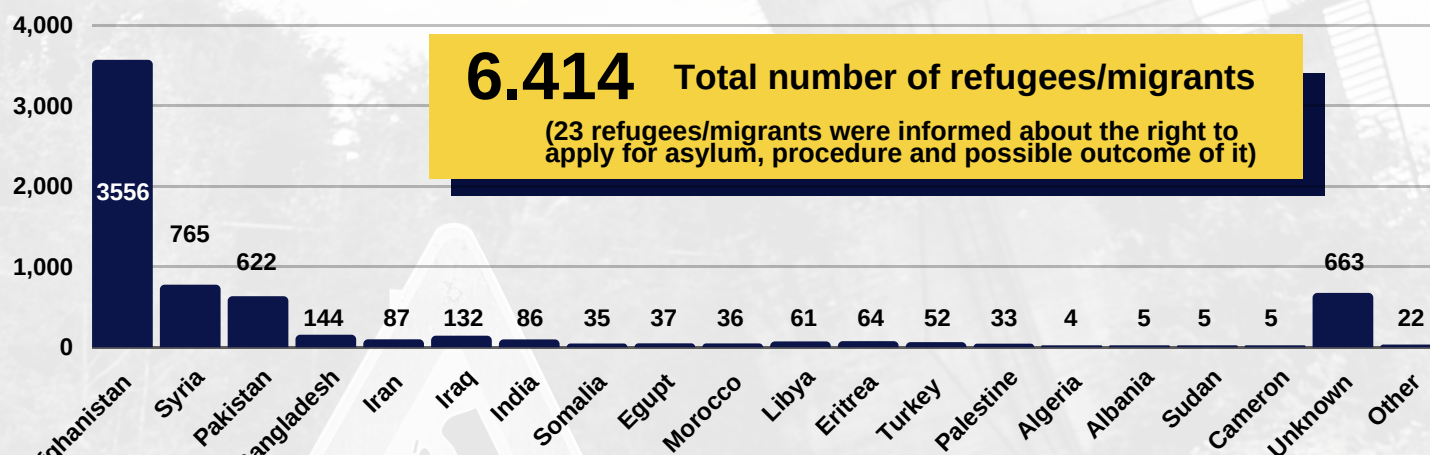

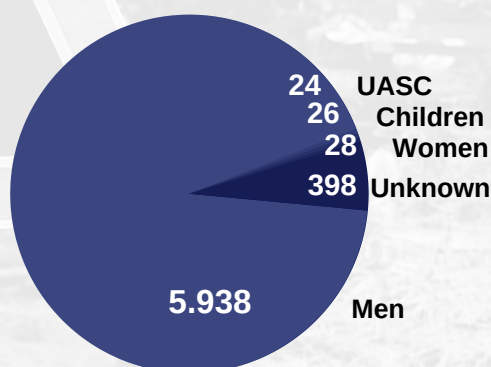

In RTC VINOJUG there are 16 refugees/migrants who were detained as witnesses in criminal procedures against the smugglers.

Specifics

The Ministry of Labor and Social Policy made decision that every asylum seeker will be placed in quarantine accommodation for fourteen days in RTC VINOJUG, with exception for foreigner who at the moment of submitting asylum request will enclose negative result from PCR test done for the purpose of the coronavirus, not older than 48 hours.

The border police brought only the refugees/migrants who were asylum seekers and some of the refugees/migrants apprehended in smuggling incidents in order to be witnesses in criminal proceedings in RTC VINOJUG.

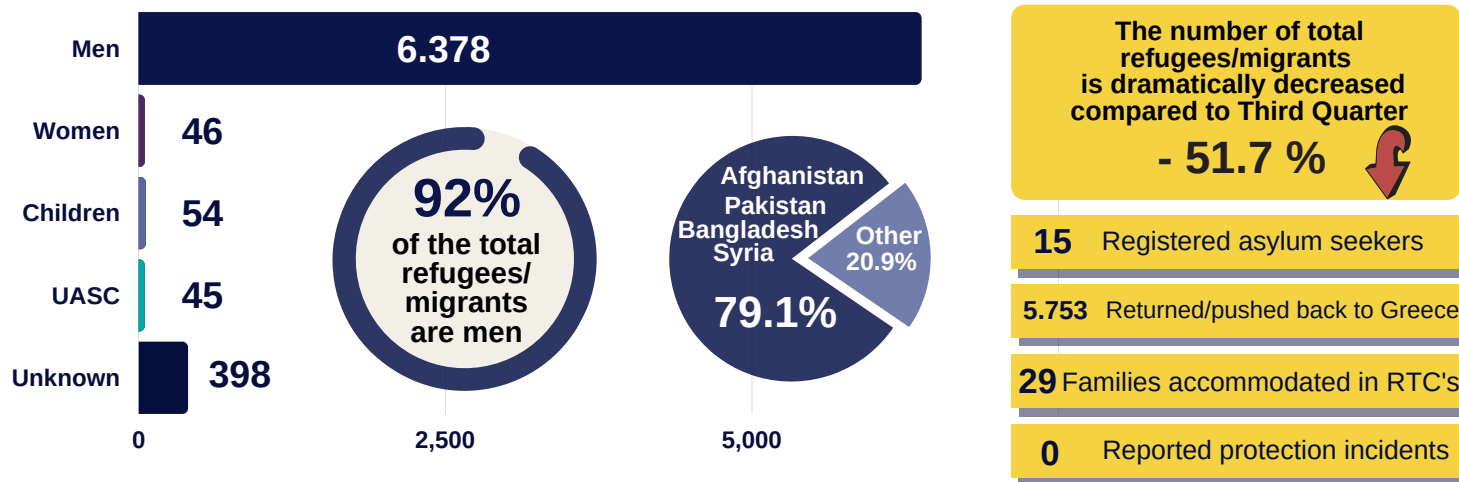

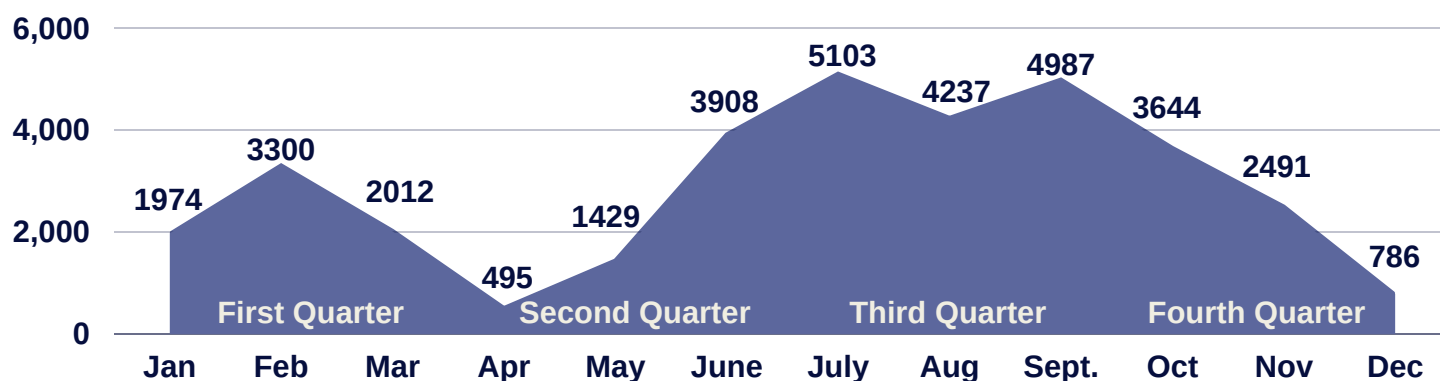

Specifics:

During reporting period in RTC Tabanovce there is increased number of refugees/migrants coming or returning from Serbia. After several unsuccessful attempts to continue their travel to some of the Western European countries, they decide to return to Greece.

The RTC Vinograd remained to be used as an accommodation site for refugees who were detained as witnesses in the criminal procedures against the smugglers.

Most of the refugees/migrants who were brought in the RTC's are refugees/migrants apprehended in criminal incidents and were needed as witness in court against traffickers and smugglers. These refugees/migrants are only a small fraction of the total number of the refugees/migrants who were apprehended in an attempt to cross state territory irregularly.

The Ministry of Labor and Social Policy decided that every asylum seeker will be placed in quarantine accommodation for fourteen days in RTC Vinograd, with exception for foreigner who at the moment of submitting asylum request will enclose negative result from PCR test done for the purpose of the coronavirus, not older than 48 hours.
