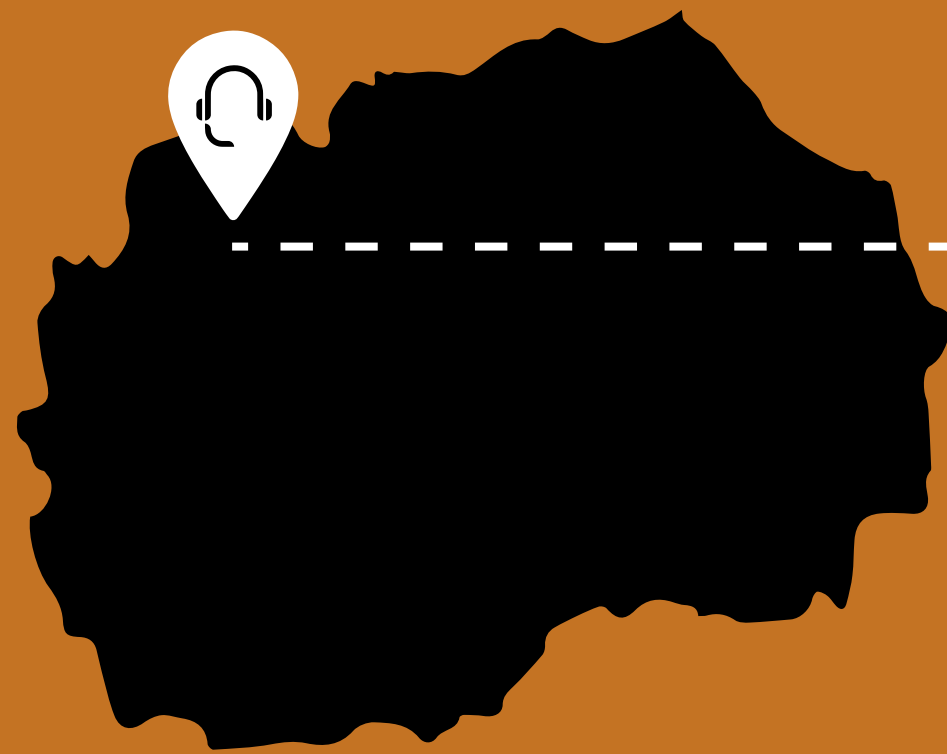

The most common legal issues for which direct legal aid was provided are as follows:
