




## **TC TABANOVCE** January - February - March 2022

#### AGE/GENDER BREAKDOWN





#### SPECIFICS

In the reporting period, 28 asylum seekers have submitted an asylum request, one at TC Vinojug and 27 at TC Tabanovce.

The border police continued bringing migrants to the centers who were apprehended in smuggling incidents to be witnesses in criminal proceedings. The rest of the apprehended migrants were returned/pushed back to Greece. Mainly TC Vinojug, but in some cases also TC Tabanovce, served as a place for detaining migrants without any legal basis for the apprehended migrants. They are detained before they give their testimonial before the public prosecutor. The number of days in detention is different in every case and depends on the schedule of the public prosecutor. The minimum number of days of detention is 1 and the maximum is 22. The accommodated migrants are only a small fraction of the total number of the migrants who were apprehended in an attempt to cross state territory irregularly.

During the reported period migrants from India and Cuba who have entered from Serbia and who were apprehended within the territory of the RNM or detained in TC Vinojug, were afterward transported to TC Tabanovce. For the persons, the police issued decisions for expulsion from the country but were returned outside of a formal procedure in Serbia or were left in TC Tabanovce.
